# The Coming Storm Part 15 After the Storm

Revelation 21-22

## I. After the storm, every last trace of the curse is washed away

**A. No more Tragedy-** (21:4, Isaiah 65:16-25)- The "former things" are all those things pertaining to the curse which cause us pain or that elicit God's judgment

#### **B.** No more Darkness

- 1.) Physical dark- (22:5, 21:23-25b)- Nothing more to fear in the night or the dark
- 2.) Spiritual dark (21:8, 21:27, 22:14-15)- No more sin of any kind
- **C. No more Mystery and uncertainty** (21:1)- The untamable, vast, uncontrollable source of fear, mystery, and terrors in Revelation is gone. *The Cambridge commentary says* "To us, the absence of sea seems, so to speak, a defect in the landscape, while to the ancients it seemed a pledge of security and of unfettered intercourse between all nations."

## II. After the storm, newness with mark all of creation (21:5)

- A. A New Heaven and new Earth (21:1)- the perfect world
- **B.** A new Jerusalem (21:2, 9-27)- the perfect city
  - 1. Note its symbolism and size (21:10)
    - a. The recurring theme of "12s" speaks to "completeness" and "perfection"
    - b. The city is described as being over 1,300 miles square at the base
    - c. The cubic shape made of gold bears a striking (and certainly intentional) resemblance to the Holy of Holies
  - **2. Note its origin and Originator** (21:2, 10, John 14:1-2; Hebrews 11:10)
  - 3. Note its unfathomable beauty- (21:11, 18-21)
  - 4. Note its unlimited access- (21:25)
- **C. A new sustenance** (22:1-2, 21:6, Genesis 3:24, Ezekiel 47:1-12)
- **D.** A new romance (21:3, 22:3-4)- The perfect relationship

# III. We are <u>blessed</u> when we look into the storm and <u>hope</u> for the time after the storm (22:6-21)

- A. Because we have seen into God's <u>truth</u>- (22:6, 8, 16)- Let this truth nourish us and feed us
- B. Because we have seen the certainty of God's <u>justice</u> (22:12. Romans 12:19)- Let it comfort us, and then challenge us to live in light of the coming storm

- C. We are blessed because it gives us the chance to escape the storm (22:14)- Let is make us thankful we have Jesus
- **D. Because we have assurance and hope (22:7, 12, 17, 20)-** Let God's promises fill us with joy and expectation as we look for the return of our Lord and Savior
