**“Riders of the Storm”**  
**Revelation 6**

- I. A Preview of the Tribulation (vs.1,17) – *“For the great day of wrath is come”*
  - A. Its’ prominence in Scripture (Rev. 6-19)
  - B. Its’ purpose
    1. To fulfill Israel’s prophecies (vs.9-11) – *“I saw the souls of them that were slain for the word of God”*
    2. To force a decision (vs.9,15)
    3. To judge unbelievers (vs.12-16) – *“fall on us”*
  - C. Its’ participants (the Four Horsemen)
    1. The White Horse (vs.1,2) – the Antichrist
    2. The Red Horse (v.4) – war
    3. The Black Horse (vs.5,6) – famine
    4. The Pale Horse (vs.7,8) – death
- II. The Perfect Storm (vs.12-14)
  - A. The fury of Satan (v.2)
  - B. The evil of men (v.4)
  - C. The wrath of God (vs.15-16) – *“the great day of his wrath is come”*
- III. Lessons from the Tribulation
  - A. A reminder that God is just (v.17) – *“Who shall be able to stand?”*
  - B. A warning to unbelievers (v.15)
  - C. A challenge to believers
